


Connect – Our Church Community

Is my information secure?

Your information is encrypted. Plus, the payment processor for Realm complies with the highest security standards in the industry.

What can church members with Realm accounts see about me?

Members with Realm accounts can see the name and photo of other Realm users. Your giving history and age are never visible to church members. Your contact information can only be seen by staff and your fellow group members. You can adjust your privacy settings to share your information with additional Realm users.

The security of your information doesn't stop there. This year, take steps to use different, random passwords for all your online accounts. Let's work together to keep things safe.

When I sign in Realm, I cannot see my giving history or my household information.
